Driving Clinic with Larry Brinker

WHERE: Legacy Stables, Shelton, Washington (between Olympia & Shelton)

CLINIC FORMAT:

This clinic will be an array of private & semi-private lessons, given over three days, in 50-55 minute sessions, to drivers from beginning/basic levels to elite level drivers who compete in CDE's at the Advanced level. This clinic will primarily be a dressage & cones clinic, held at a facility with an indoor arena, and may even get to be the host of a "Centennial Drive" for a special member of our driving community.

NOTE: For those who do not know, a Centennial Drive is where the age of the driver and the age of the pony are added together and must equal over 100. To qualify, the pony & driver must complete an ADS dressage test for a licensed judge.

COSTS:

Private lesson: \$150/session (50-55 minutes)
Semi-private lesson: \$85/each driver (50-55 minutes)

❖ Stabling at RMF: \$30/night w/ initial bag of bedding included

- Additional bedding is available for \$15/bag. Pre-order with Annie is required to guarantee bedding is available
- o Those stabling are welcome to bring their own bedding of choice
- ✓ Costs include all facility/arena haul in fees for Legacy Stables

STABLING:

For this clinic, Legacy Stables does not have any stalls available to us. Annie will be hauling in daily from the farm (Rainbow Meadow Farm, Rochester, Washington) and does currently have a few stalls that could be made available. • For all lessons, <u>50% of the balance is due 2 weeks prior to the clinic</u> (by February 7, 2025), with the remainder of the balance payable when you check in at the clinic (Feb 21-23).

REFUNDS:

❖ SNOW CLAUSE

- There is always a risk running a clinic/event in February as our Pacific Northwest weather can be a bit fickle & unpredictable. With that said, we should have relatively accurate weather forecasts within the 2-week mark of the clinic (which is also the due date for the deposit Friday February 7, 2025).
- o If we have snow (>2") or daytime "high" temps below 25 degrees, we will have to cancel/postpone the clinic (as Annie will not drive a trailer in it for a non-emergency, nor ask anyone else to!) and all fees would be 100% refundable.
